

# HOW TO:

## Install a cordura cover to a jockey seat

**A. Prepare Side Velcro Straps**

Start by locating the Velcro straps situated on the sides of the seat. Unpeel these straps and swap the placement so that the soft bottom layer is switched with the rough top layer, leaving the soft part exposed. Repeat this action on the other side of the seat.

**B. Place Cover Over Backrest and Handles**

Slide the longest part of the cover over the backrest of the seat. As the cover reaches the side handles, the fit will become snug, but continue pushing down until the handles pop through the side holes.

**C. Secure Back and Define Symmetry**

Flip the seat so the bolts are facing you. Slide the back part of the cover over the back of the seat. For a symmetrical finish, use the stitch lines on the cover as a guide against the shape of the seat.

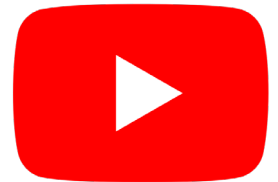

**D. Pull Cover Over Pommel**

Flip the seat onto its back. Take the very front of the cover and pull it over the pommel of the seat. Ensure you pull this section until the seam of the cover is settled underneath the edge of the seat. Push around this area to allow the material to settle in its correct place.

**E. Final Side and Underside Placement**

Take the remaining parts of the cover and slide them over, and then under the seat. Use the stitching lines in this area as a guide to ensure a symmetrical finish. Pat and tuck any areas that appear loosely fitted.

**F. Secure Velcro Fastening**

Flip the seat back onto its base. Go to the handles where you can now swap the Velcro back around, fastening the strap securely underneath the side handle. Give the Velcro a swipe to secure it. Repeat this securing action for the strap on the other side. Check that the underside of the seat is properly secured.
